We are excited to let you know that we will be celebrating **World Book Day** in school!

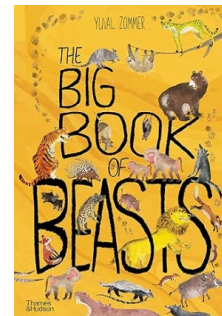
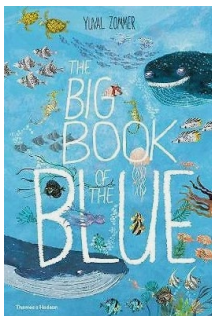
Although World Book Day officially falls on **Thursday 5th March**, due to staffing we will be celebrating it a day earlier on **Wednesday 4th March**.
