Dear Families,

Year 5 – Kilve Residential – 5th to 7th July 2023

We are offering pupils in Year 5 the chance to go on a residential visit to Kilve. During this residential, the children will take part in a variety of activities that will help with their personal growth, confidence, resilience and independence. The challenges provided are beyond what we could offer in school.

Kilve Outdoor Centre is situated in 40 acres of wooded grounds at the foot of the Quantock Hills. The catering at Kilve is exceptionally good and provision is made for special dietary requirements if necessary.

We will leave school on Wednesday 5th July at approximately 9.30 a.m. and return on Friday 7th July at approximately 2.00 pm.

The cost will be £225 per child. This includes accommodation, meals, activities and travel. If you wish for your child to attend the Kilve Residential, complete the forms below together with a payment £56.25 by **31st January 2023**. If you wish to pay in full by that date, that is also an option. If however you wish to pay by instalments we would request the following:

1st instalment: £56.25 by 31st January 2023

2nd instalment: £56.25 by 28th February 2023

3rd instalment: £56.25 by 31st March 2023

4th instalment: £56.25 by 30th April 2023

Payments can be made via ParentMail or cheque, made payable to Somerset County Council. Please remember **we do not accept cash payments**.

It is very important that if difficulties are experienced in meeting the cost of this residential that you speak to Mrs Constanza as soon as possible to arrange a payment plan.
