Organisers of the Wells Festival of Literature have invited Year 6 to hear the author, Dan Smith, talk about his work and his book Nisha's War.

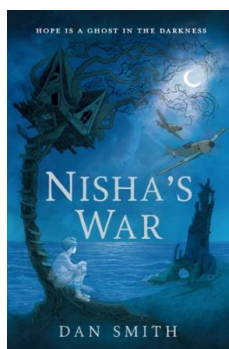
