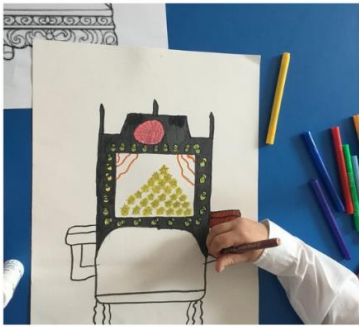

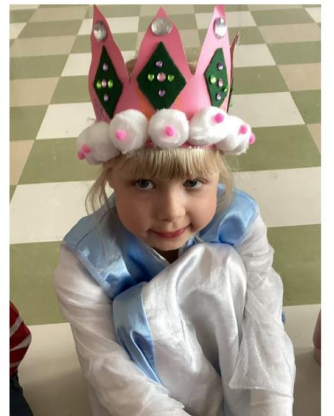


## Year 5

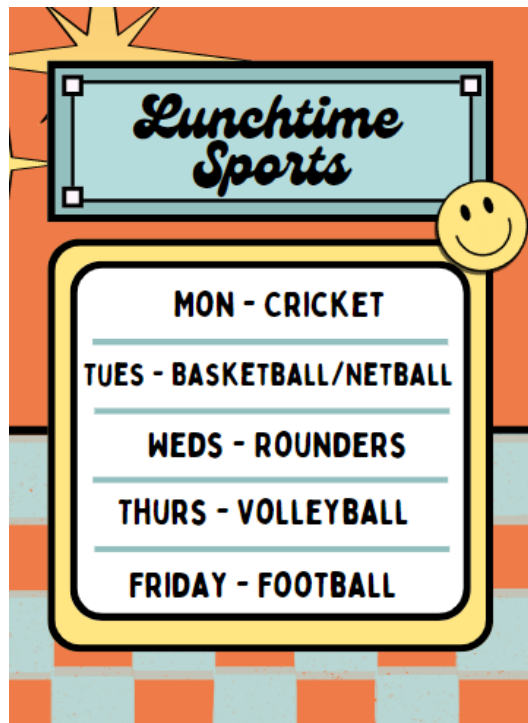


## OPAL
