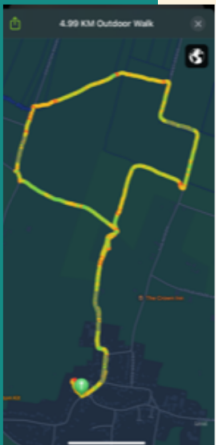
### Let's Get Ready to Ramble!
