### **Flooding Update – School Closure**

As many of you may be aware we unfortunately have had a burst water pipe that was discovered last Sunday in our Year 4 classroom. We cannot be sure when the pipe burst but the damage to the classrooms has been significant.

I would like to thank all of you who messaged details for plumbers or came and helped that day, it was a real show of community support which made the crisis much easier to tackle.

Since Sunday, I have been working with the County Insurance team and flood restoration company. We were advised yesterday that the rooms are not safe to use at this time and will need some immediate repairs.

It is with regret that because of this incident, school will need to be closed for one day to all children on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September.

We will be able to re-open to all children on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> September. This will allow us time to reorganise the remaining classrooms and install additional equipment to enable all the children to access school from this date. I apologise for the short notice and the inconvenience this may cause.

I will update you all next week to confirm the class arrangements for Thursday.
