RE: School Opening Plans

Dear families,

Thank you for your patience as we have been working to get school safe and ready for your children tomorrow. We have been working closely with the Health and Safety team at County Hall and the Insurance Team, who are advising us how best to move forward. Sadly, neither the Year 3, or Year 4 classrooms will be usable for some time due to the significant water damage.

We initially requested additional classrooms from County, sadly they were not able to provide these. Instead, they offered to transport Year 3 and Year 4 to neighbouring schools. We refused this offer and have instead been working to create teaching spaces for all children in school.

We can now confirm that we are able to re-open to all children from Thursday 7th September. Classroom arrangements are as follows:

Reception and Year One – Reception classroom, please drop off and collect at the wooden gate.

Year Two – Year One classroom, please drop off and collect from the side door by the hall.

Year Three – Year Six classroom, please drop off at the classroom and collect from the playground.

Year Four – Year Two classroom, please drop off and collect from the side door by the Quiet Garden.

Year Five and Six - Year Five classroom, please drop off at the classroom and collect from the playground.

It is going to be a 'Squash and a Squeeze' for a little while, but we can accommodate everyone and most importantly keep our community together.

Thank you once again for your support and understanding. We look forward to seeing you all tomorrow morning. Gates will be open from 8.45am.
