Wilow: My favourite memory was the abseiling because I was scared at first but then after I did it I really liked it.

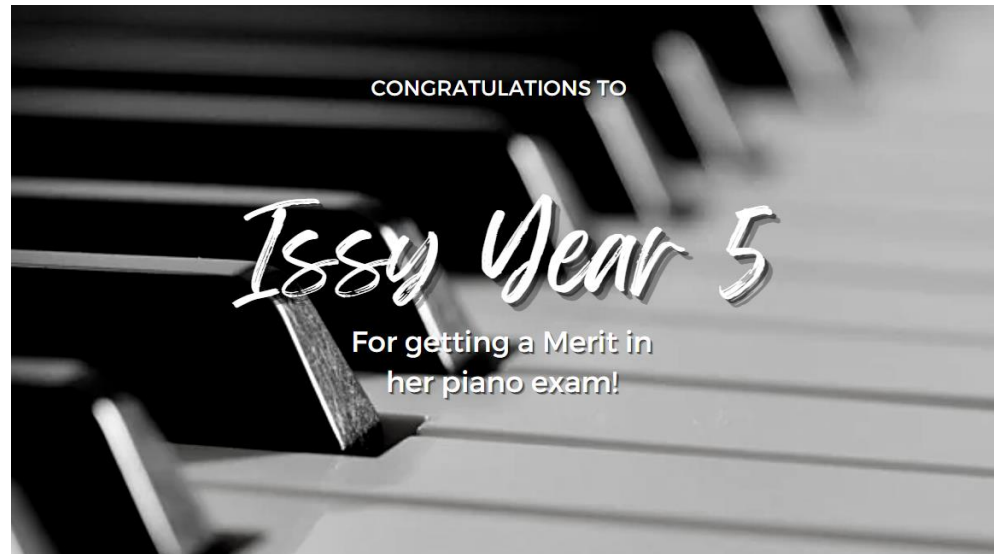
