As you will be aware the recent weather has left many local areas flooded or with high levels of risk of flooding. Many roads have been closed and some still are. Today we received an email from the Local Authority regarding a further weather warning and the Met Office have forecast that there will be rain from approximately 6.00pm throughout the night until tomorrow evening.

We will only close the school as a final resort and we need to ensure the safety of pupils and staff when making these decisions.

We will monitor the situation overnight and throughout the day tomorrow.

Please make decisions on whether to travel tomorrow based on your own risk assessments and the latest travel advice.

If the situation worsens through the day tomorrow, please make sure you have access to your emails as this is the best way for us to keep you updated on any decisions we need to make.

This is especially important if you are relying on School or Public Transport, or you have booked breakfast club or TLE.

Please consider alternative pick-up arrangements so that you and your child know that they can get home safely.
